Policy Details:

- 1. Each kindergarten will have where possible, a Parent/Whānau Group to support the staff with the non-teaching operations of the kindergarten and to foster goodwill between the kindergarten and its community.
- 2. The structure and functioning of the group will be flexible to meet the needs of individual kindergartens.
- 3. The Association is accepting of variations of groups that support individual kindergartens, especially those that are not able to form a Parents/Whānau Group.
- 4. Common functions of the group are likely to involve fundraising for special projects or purchases at the kindergarten, as well as coordinating social events to foster good community relationships.
- 5. The group should be inclusive and open to all family/whānau of the kindergarten and hold its meetings at a time that provides the best opportunity for family/whānau to attend.
- 6. The Association will provide a framework to assist groups to function effectively.
